For Unique Circumstances

What happens if I am traveling and need dental services?

Out of State:

Please visit https://deltadentalco.com and use the "Find a Dentist" tool to locate an in-network provider in your current area. This ensures you receive the highest level of benefits and cost savings.

International Travel:

Members are responsible for paying dental claims directly when receiving care outside the United States. To request reimbursement, a completed claim form, an itemized statement with cost per service (in English) and proof of payment must be submitted. The claim form can be downloaded from our <u>website</u>. Please ensure all documentation is provided for timely processing.

How does it work if I live in 2 states during a calendar year?

If you reside in two states during the calendar year, please ensure your dental provider verifies the services available under your plan in each location. Additionally, confirm that all claims are submitted to Delta Dental of Colorado to prevent any delays in processing and reimbursement.



Frequently Asked Questions Continued

How do you determine if dental issues are considered 'medical' or 'dental'?

The determination of whether an issue is considered medical or dental depends on the nature and origin of the condition, as well as the type of treatment being performed. Generally, if the service or condition involves the teeth, gums, or supporting structures and is primarily related to oral health, it's considered dental.

If the condition originates outside the mouth, affects the body as a whole, or requires treatment due to a medical condition or trauma (such as an accident, infection spreading beyond the mouth, or surgery needed for medical reasons), it's typically considered medical.

For example:

- **Dental**: Routine cleanings, fillings, crowns, and root canals.
- Medical: Jaw fractures, oral surgery for tumor removal, or dental treatment required due to a medical condition like cancer or congenital defects.

In some cases, both medical and dental coverage may apply depending on the diagnosis, procedure, and insurance plan guidelines.


